The 2SK3358 is N-Channel MOS Field Effect Transistor designed for high current switching applications.


**TEST CIRCUIT 1 AVALANCHE CAPABILITY**



**TEST CIRCUIT 2 SWITCHING TIME**




**TEST CIRCUIT 3 GATE CHARGE**




1)TO-220AB (MP-25)




2)TO-262 (MP-25 Fin Cut)

**Remark** The diode connected between the gate and source of the transistor serves as a protector against ESD. When this device actually used, an additional protection circuit is externally required if a voltage exceeding the rated voltage may be applied to this device.

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
